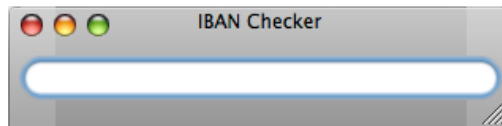

Summary

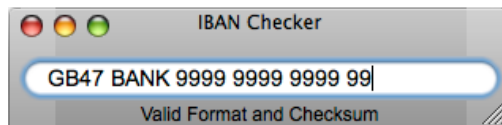
IBAN Checker is a simple Widget which checks the format and checksum of an IBAN number.

Instructions

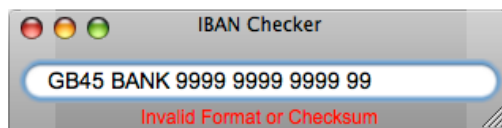
When the Widget is first started, it displays a window like this:



Enter an IBAN number, then press the return (or enter) key.



If the format of the number is correct for the country indicated by the first two letters and its checksum is also correct, that is reported as shown above.



If the format of the IBAN number is incorrect or the checksum test fails, that is reported as shown above.

You should NEVER attempt to correct an IBAN. If the IBAN check fails, you should ask the account holder for the correct IBAN. Correcting the check digits does NOT mean that the resulting number is a valid IBAN.

Note that only an account holder's bank is authorized to create an IBAN. Do not attempt to construct an IBAN yourself - such a number may be invalid, even if it passes the tests performed by this Widget.
